Tip #1

- Read the question and research. What exactly are they asking you to answer?
- Begin writing your intro paragraph. Start with an attention grabber for the first sentence.

Tip#2

- Be authentic when writing your story. Talk about your life experiences.

Tip #3

- Write your draft and then come back to it the next day for revisions.

Tip #4

- Check for grammar errors and spelling mistakes. Grammarly will catch these for you.

- Did you stay on topic and answer the question?
